Parma Senior Center to host “Farmer’s Market” for low income seniors

(Parma, OH) – On Thursday, August 30, between 9 AM and 1 PM, the Parma Senior Center will be the site of a “Senior Farmer’s Market Nutrition” program. It is available to those seniors who qualified for the program. It will provide supplemental fruits and vegetables at no cost to meet the needs of 60 and older, low income residents throughout Cuyahoga County.

Farmers from Holmes County will be on hand to purvey their goods. Eligible seniors have already received nine, five-dollar vouchers to purchase their selections of fruits and vegetables. Only produce that is locally grown will be available. (No citrus fruits or bananas)

Cash purchases will also be accepted.

The Parma Senior Center was recently designated a “Senior Farmer’s Nutrition” site by the Western Reserve Area Agency on Aging which oversees the program.
